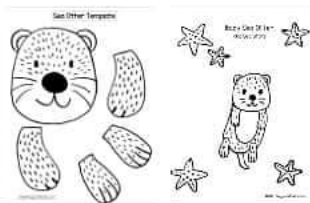
White cardstock (or other paper, with the template printed)
